The Parish Council is organising a Community Fridge. It will be sited inside the church corridor. The Reverend and church wardens have generously agreed to provide this space for us all to access the contents of the fridge.

It will contain perishable, fresh food, available to us all. We can share perfectly edible, surplus food instead of it being trucked off to landfill sites. 70 kilos of food is wasted, per person, per year in the UK, 70% of which is still edible.

It will help put a stop to food waste, whether it is donated by local businesses, supermarkets, restaurants, allotments or surplus food from our own refrigerators.

By sharing food we can bring the community together - caring for those who would appreciate some help and promoting a more sustainable future.
